Stop Press 782 – Aer Lingus Cabin Crew Strike 30 May 2014

As you may be aware, EI have been given notice that the trade union representing their cabin crew, is intending to engage in strike action for a 24 hour period, commencing at 00.01 on Friday 30 May.

Whilst EI continue to seek a resolution, Virgin Atlantic is adopting the following policy for passengers in the event that industrial action is taken, which will result in flight cancellations or disruptions.

For any VS/932 tickets issued on/before 21 May 2014 who are due to travel on EI DUB-LHR, ORK-LHR or SNN-LHR on 30 May 2014 connecting onto VS, please re-accommodate them on alternative flights between 20 May 2014 & 9 June 2014 inclusive. Please ensure the lowest available booking class within the same cabin is used and include the following OSI message:

“SI VS INVOL REROUTE DUE TO STRIKE”

Alternatively, a full refund may be given and a new ticket re fared for travel on BA DUB-LHR services in accordance with the applicable fare conditions.

Please note that EI's DUB-LGW and all BFS services are unaffected.
