UPDATE: Virgin Atlantic expand leisure routes for next summer

We need to let you know that next summer Virgin Atlantic will launch two new direct services for UK holiday makers between Belfast and Orlando and Glasgow and Las Vegas.

Virgin Atlantic is expanding its existing Orlando and Las Vegas services to help meet high demand to these popular leisure destinations for customers based in Northern Ireland and Scotland - and will be the only scheduled airline to fly these routes.

Both of these routes will form part of Virgin Atlantic's Joint Venture with Delta Air Lines, with the US carrier offering the service for sale under the codeshare agreement. Customers will be able to use Delta's services out of each airport to connect onwards in the US, such as from Orlando to Dallas, Texas and from Las Vegas to Seattle.

A Boeing 747-400 aircraft will operate these seasonal services on a weekly basis, flying on Thursdays. The aircraft flying to both US destinations will be configured with 14 Upper Class seats, 66 Premium Economy seats and 375 seats in Economy.

Belfast to Orlando

This service will operate in June and July, commencing 25th June 2015. These flights from Northern Ireland will add an additional 3,600 Virgin Atlantic seats to and from the Sunshine State over the season. Seats will be going on sale this week through Virgin Atlantic from the 25th July.

Glasgow to Las Vegas

The service will operate in September and October, commencing 10th September 2015. These flights from Glasgow will add an additional 3,600 Virgin Atlantic seats to and from the world's entertainment capital over the peak season. Seats will be going on sale through the airline direct from mid-October.
