Summer 2017 Leisure Changes

We're excited to announce that in April next year, we will launch a new year-round service between London Gatwick and Varadero, one of Cuba's most popular beach resort towns. We're also increasing services to Barbados, Florida and Las Vegas for Summer 2017.

The new weekly year-round service from Gatwick to Varadero will start on 2 April 2017. Complementing our existing twice weekly London Gatwick-Havana service, the new route will give more customers the opportunity to explore Cuba, as well as the added flexibility of being able to fly directly to the city or the beach.

We're also increasing the number of services on some of our existing summer 2017 leisure routes to Barbados, Florida and Las Vegas by operating our fleet more efficiently. Enabling us to meet increased demand during peak season and offering customers more choice when they fly.

Building on high demand, we're doubling the number of flights between Belfast and Orlando during June and July, giving customers in Northern Ireland more opportunities to escape to the Sunshine State. We're adding extra services from Glasgow, Manchester and London Gatwick too.

A summary of all the changes to our summer 2017 leisure service, and the new London Gatwick-Varadero service, are listed below:

London Gatwick

- New weekly year-round service from London Gatwick to Varadero launching from 2 April 2017.
- Increasing services from London Gatwick to Las Vegas. We'll operate nine flights per week in April and May (up from seven). These additional flights will be on Monday and Wednesday.
- Increasing services from London Gatwick to Barbados. We'll operate nine flights per week in April 2017. The extra days will be Wednesday and Sunday.
- Reducing our service between London Gatwick and Montego Bay. We're always looking to make sure that our services meet our customers' needs and, to better match supply to demand on this route, we're reducing our flights from three to two per week during May, June, September and October.

Belfast

- Doubling our service from Belfast to Orlando in the Northern Irish school holidays. We'll operate two flights per week for a four-week period during June and July.

Glasgow

- Increasing service between Glasgow and Orlando to four flights per week for a four-week period during June and July.

Manchester

- Increasing services from Manchester to Barbados. We'll operate two flights per week on an A330, rather than one per week on a 744. We'll increase further to three per week during the school holiday period from late July to the end of August.
- Increasing services on our Manchester to Orlando route. We'll add one extra weekly flight in late July until the end of August, taking us to 14 services per week in this period.
