UPDATE: Unaccompanied Minors and Young Person Travelling Alone – YPTA

The unaccompanied minor policy was recently been reviewed and there has been an update as shown below:

Young Passengers aged 12 to 17 years old

Children aged between 12 – 18 years (*up to and including the day before his or her 18th birthday*) may opt to be classified as an unaccompanied minor; however this is not mandatory (with the exception of JNB/BGI which is compulsory) and they can decline.

Young travellers who do not opt to enrol into the UMNR programme must be registered as a YPTA (Young Person Travelling Alone) and a relevant SSR added to their PNR. This will ensure these customers are flagged to the airport staff and visible to our crew.
