VSbulletin 073 – Update - Delta Air Lines realigns booking classes

Delta has realigned booking classes for their domestic flights; the realignment has moved Domestic First Class from F to C inventory. This change, effective as of November 3, 2018, is for travel on or after April 2, 2019 and follows the pilot that went into effect October 20, 2018, in Seattle (SEA) markets, for travel on or after November 1, 2018.

This change aligns the Virgin Atlantic and Delta Air Lines booking classes.

- F, P, A and G inventory will continue to be used for Delta Premium Select
- In addition to its Delta Premium Select (DPS) product, F inventory will be used by Delta Air Lines for marketed code-share product on partner-operated flights with a true International First Class product such as Air France's La Premiere
- Markets served by a mix of aircraft which feature Delta One and First Class will continue to use booking classes F, P, A, G and R until further notice. These markets include: JFK-SAN, JFK-SEA, JFK-LAS and BOS-LAX

Existing bookings on Virgin Atlantic 932 ticket stock will be re-validated, however, if the ticket has not been re-validated, the ticket must be reissued as an even exchange. In addition, the PNR and ticket must be documented as noted below.
